

The Words of Jesus About Women

1. "Should not this woman, a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has kept bound for eighteen long years, be set free on the Sabbath day from what bound her?"
2. "I tell you the truth, [she] has put in more than all the others. All these people gave their gifts out of their wealth; but she out of her poverty put in all she had to live on."
3. "... I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven—as her great love has shown. But whoever has been forgiven little loves little."
4. "Why are you bothering this woman? She has done a beautiful thing to me.... I tell you the truth, wherever this gospel is preached throughout the world, what she has done will also be told, in memory of her."

The Words of Jesus to Women

5. "Then neither do I condemn you," Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."
6. "Daughter, your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering."
7. "Woman, you are set free from your infirmity."
8. "Do not hold on to me, for I have not yet returned to the Father. Go instead to my brothers and tell them, 'I am returning to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God.'"
9. "Do not weep for me; weep for yourselves and for your children..."
10. "Dear woman, here is your son."
11. "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, but whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life."
12. "Don't cry."
13. "Woman, you have great faith! Your request is granted."
14. "You don't know what you are asking."
15. "You are worried and upset about many things, but only one thing is needed. Mary has chosen what is better, and it will not be taken away from her."
16. "I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?"
17. "Did I not tell you that if you believed, you would see the glory of God?"
18. "Your sins are forgiven. ...Your faith has saved you; go in peace."
